

Total duration: 3h



E-MTB

Introducing “GEO TRAILS,” our intermediate e-mountain bike adventure tour. Experience a quality full-suspension e-MTB while exploring the picturesque surroundings near Hveragerði village. This fun and easy day tour is suitable for all active people that love the outdoors. The trip duration depends on your preferred speed and distance.

The trails showcase the Geothermal energy bubbling below our feet plus lava fields, small waterfalls, rivers and steamy mudpools. Riding an e-MTB is a fun way to explore nature and getting a little help with pedalling uphill is a great way to experience this mesmerising landscape. We make frequent stops to take everything in; the views, the silence, the smell. And then we head on, smile on our faces.

From the back of an Icelandic horse you'll feel closer to nature than you've ever felt before. The Icelandic horse is small, strong and sure-footed, and it carries you comfortably across rough terrain. The colorful breed is characterized by its friendly spirit and many gaits, particularly the special tölt, which can be slow or fast but always super smooth. The tour itself takes 1–1.5 hours, depending on your preference, and an additional 30 minutes is required beforehand for preparation and gear-up.

Lava Tunnel

Distance from RVK: 40km
Transport one way: 40min
Activity duration: 1h
Total duration: 3h



Caving in Iceland is a dark, strange and unique experience. You walk into a world that once was glowing hot and bright but now is frozen black. In winter you even have ice stalagmites that can give the adventurer an otherworldly feeling. Our lava caves are like veins of the volcanoes as molten lava flows through lava fields and forms these tunnels. When the volcano sleeps again it leaves behind empty shells that turn into an exciting underworld of caves for us to explore. Our caving experience is special as we blend together a caving expedition and folklore, learning about the Elves or hidden people, ghosts, outlaws and other strange creatures of Iceland. A journey into Raufarhólshellir is a unique experience and a great opportunity to witness the inner workings of a volcanic eruption as one walks in the path of lava that flowed during the Leitahehraun eruption, which occurred east of the Bláfjöll mountains about 5200 years ago.

Fly Over Iceland



Blue Lagoon

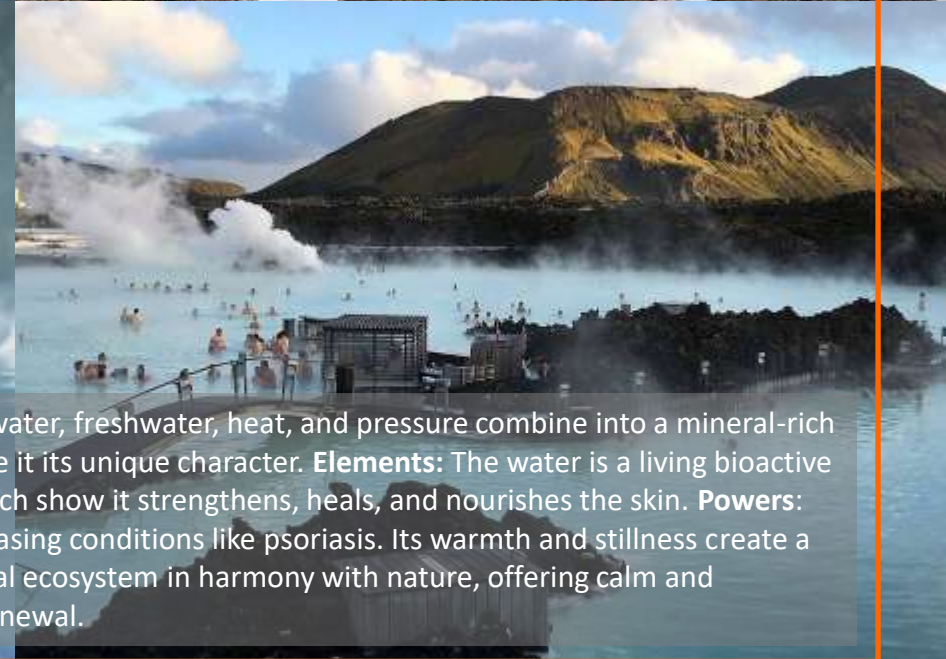
Distance from RVK: 50km

Total duration: 4h-4.5h



Named one of 25 wonders of the world by *National Geographic* in 2012, the Blue Lagoon in Iceland was honoured for its unique geothermal seawater. Found nowhere else on earth, this renowned resource is rich in silica, algae, and minerals - the elements that give the lagoon its healing powers.



Origins: Blue Lagoon water forms 2,000 meters underground as seawater, freshwater, heat, and pressure combine into a mineral-rich blend. As it rises, it absorbs silica and meets rare microalgae that give it its unique character. **Elements:** The water is a living bioactive mix of silica, minerals, and blue-green microalgae. Decades of research show it strengthens, heals, and nourishes the skin. **Powers:** Immersion in the lagoon provides physical and emotional renewal, easing conditions like psoriasis. Its warmth and stillness create a deeply restorative experience. **Ecosystem:** The lagoon is a geothermal ecosystem in harmony with nature, offering calm and rejuvenation. Visitors leave with a lasting sense of connection and renewal.



Snorkeling

Distance from RVK: 55km
Transport one way: 1h
Activity duration: 2.5h
Total duration: 5h

Silfra, the fissure between the continents:

About 40 min drive from your hotel in Reykjavik to snorkeling location. The Silfra fissure, is known as one of the top dive sites in the world for two main reasons.

First, the Silfra fissure is actually a crack between the North American and Eurasian continents, meaning that you dive or snorkel right where the continental plates meet and drift apart about 2cm per year.

Silfra is the only place where one can dive or snorkel directly in the crack between two continental plates.

Secondly, the underwater visibility in the Silfra fissure is over 100 meters, which creates an underwater experience that will rarely, if ever, be surpassed. The reasons for this astounding water clarity are twofold: the water is cold (2°C – 4°C year round) as it is glacial water from the nearby Langjökull and this water is filtered through porous underground lava for 30-100 years until it reaches the north end of Thingvellir lake, seeping out from underground wells. The Silfra water is as pristine as water can get and you can drink it at anytime during your dive or snorkel.

ATV

Distance from RVK: 55km
Transport one way: 1h
Activity duration: 1h
Total duration: 3h




Join us on an unforgettable ATV adventure where history and raw nature meet. Starting from Grindavík, we ride out to the brand-new lava field that recently flowed into the town, a dramatic reminder of the volcanic power shaping this area.

Along the way we explore the rugged Reykjanes Peninsula, formed by an eruption in the very same place over 2000 years ago. You'll witness the contrast between the fresh black lava and the ancient volcanic landscapes, experiencing how Grindavík has always lived in the shadow of fire and stone.

The tour takes you up close to the new craters, where we stop to admire the view and capture the moment of standing on ground that only months ago was molten lava. It's a unique opportunity to see Grindavík's story written both in ancient geology and in brand-new volcanic creation.

Helicopter

Distance from RVK: 3-4km
Transport one way: 8-10min
Activity duration: 35min
Total duration: 1h



Indulge in a bird's eye view of Iceland's nature.


On this tour, your pilot chooses your scenic adventure! Experience views of majestic Iceland as you fly over rugged mountain terrain and lava fields you may even be standing on a glacier. Don't forget your camera as these views are not to be missed.

Take off will be decided by the pilot the day before the trip. As often, it is the weather that controls our plans here in Iceland. Flights, landings, and routes may vary due to weather and at the pilot's discretion.

Your flight is subject to favorable weather conditions.

Sea Angling

Distance from RVK: 0-1km
Transport one way: Walk
Activity duration: 2.5h-3h
Total duration: 3h



We set off from Reykjavik's Old Harbour and head out to Faxaflói Bay, where our experienced fishermen will usually spot fish in a flash! If you haven't been sea fishing before, don't worry, it is very easy, and the crew will happily show you the ropes, advising you on bait and passing on their knowledge of the seas. On our sea angling trips you have a good chance of catching cod, halibut, haddock, rockfish and pollock. The sea angling tours are perfectly suited both to experienced fishermen and to those who simply wish to relax and enjoy the beautiful surrounding with a fishing rod in hand. Barbecuing the fish caught is indeed available and a popular option for the proud fishermen! Light BBQ on board catch.

Perlan Museum

- Wonders of Iceland -

Distance from RVK: 4km
Transport one way: 10min
Activity duration: 1.5h
Total duration: 2h

At Perlan, you truly get to know Iceland - an island shaped by fire and ice. Through immersive, world-class exhibitions, you feel the natural forces that formed the country and continue to transform it today.

Highlights include the real indoor ice cave, interactive glacier and volcano displays, lifelike seabird cliffs, and the new lava experience, where you're surrounded by the sights and sounds of volcanic power deep beneath the Earth's surface. The Áróra Planetarium offers a stunning Northern Lights show year-round, and the 360° observation deck provides one of Reykjavík's most impressive panoramic views.



National Museum of Iceland

Distance from RVK: 1-2km
Transport one way: 5min
Activity duration: 1h-1.5h
Total duration: 1.5h

Explore the heritage and history of Iceland from the thrilling Viking era to modern times with this entry ticket for the National Museum of Iceland in Reykjavík. The museum's permanent exhibition offers a unique insight into the history of the Icelandic nation from the Settlement to the present day, guided by the question: What makes a nation?

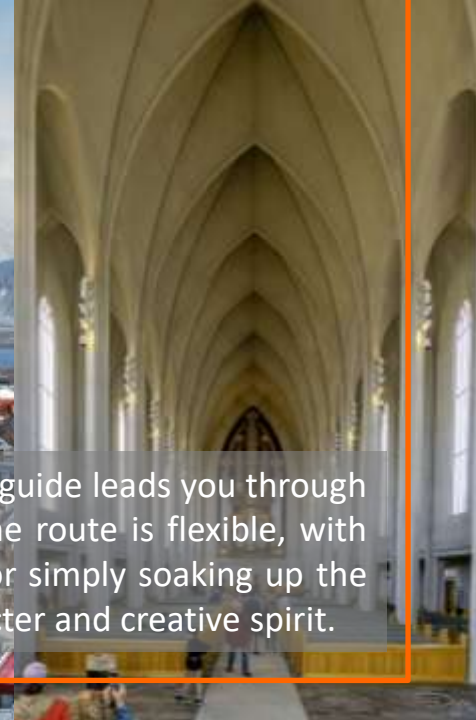
It is conceived as a journey through time: it begins with the ship in which medieval settlers crossed the ocean to their new home, it ends in a modern airport, the Icelanders' gateway to the world.

The exhibition includes about 2000 artifacts, dating from the Settlement Age to the present, as well as photographs from the 20th century.

You'll see the famous figure of Thor, dated from the year 1000, the first bible printed in Iceland in the 16th century, still considered one of the most beautiful prints in Icelandic and beautiful artifacts from mediaeval churches - among other fascinating artifacts.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Banks are open from 09:15 to 16:00. As general rule offices are open from 09:00 to 17:00, in some cases during the summer these hours are from 08:00 to 16:00. Shops are open from 09:00 to 18:00 on weekdays. Credit cards are accepted by most shops, restaurants and organizations and are widely used. The major credit cards in Iceland are Visa and Master Card, although other cards are accepted as well in some places. Tax-free shopping/tax refund. A refund of the local Value Added Tax is available to visitors to Iceland. The refund will result in a reduction of up to 15% of the retail price, provided departure from Iceland is within 30 days after the purchase is made. The purchased amount must be no less than ISK 6.000,- ([VAT included](#)) per sales receipt, and all goods (except woolens) must be packed in sealed bags or containers.

The Icelandic climate is warmer than the name suggests, thanks to the Gulf Stream. Summers in Iceland are rather cool, while the winters are relatively warm. The average monthly summer temperature ranges from 10 to 13 °C. During the summer the climate is mild but unstable with possible rain and frequent weather changes. The daily temperature can fluctuate from a minimum 5 °C at night to a maximum of 25 °C during the day.
