
Accommodation: Hotel Reykjavik Marina 4*



This day we drive:


- 1. To the countryside to Thingvellir National Park —walk among the geological wonders of the fissure zone and in the footsteps of the early Viking settlers where the Althingi parliament was founded. It's the UNESCO world heritage site and the site of the original Althingi, considered the oldest democratic parliament in the world. This area is noted for its spectacular lava formations and being the only place in the world where you can see the separation of the North American and European tectonic plates.
- 2. Lunch.
- 3. To the Geysir, the "geyser" which gave its name to all other erupting hot springs hear the bubbling of the mud pots, smell the sulfur in the air and watch in awe as the geyser Strokkur blasts boiling water into the air. The Geysir geothermal area boasts spouting springs, including Strokkur, the most active geyser in Iceland.
- 4. Actvivity : Snowmobiling and Glacier Ice Cavre
- 5. You will visit the Golden Waterfall Gullfoss feel the mist of glacial water as it cascades down one of Iceland's most famous waterfalls. Gullfoss you are given the opportunity to stand next to the amazing waterfall, watching enormous quantities of water tumble violently into a deep, meandering gorge.
- 6. Option : Icelandic lager, shark and brennivin on the way.



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The Icelandic climate is warmer than the name suggests, thanks to the Gulf Stream. Summers in Iceland are rather cool, while the winters are relatively warm. The average monthly summer temperature ranges from 10 to 13 °C. During the summer the climate is mild but unstable with possible rain and frequent weather changes. The daily temperature can fluctuate from a minimum 5 °C at night to a maximum of 25 °C during the day.

Banks are open from 09:15 to 16:00. As general rule offices are open from 09:00 to 17:00, in some cases during the summer these hours are from 08:00 to 16:00. Shops are open from 09:00 to 18:00 on weekdays. Credit cards are accepted by most shops, restaurants and organizations and are widely used. The major credit cards in Iceland are Visa and Master Card, although other cards are accepted as well in some places. Tax-free shopping/tax refund. A refund of the local Value Added Tax is available to visitors to Iceland. The refund will result in a reduction of up to 15% of the retail price, provided departure from Iceland is within 30 days after the purchase is made. The purchased amount must be no less than ISK 5.000,- (VAT included) per sales receipt, and all goods (except woolens) must be packed in sealed bags or containers.

Option: Buggy Cars (half day)

Strap into a two-seat Buggy with your partner and prepare to overcome obstacles in the rugged landscape by the slopes the valley, climbing hills, running through river beds, and more. This is an especially designed tour for you who craves bumpy, dusty, dirty driving thrills. No extra charge for dust, mud, water splashes, or even snow!

The Buggies are equipped with 4-point safety harnesses for safety, automatic transmission for driving ease. All you need is a spirit for adventure, and a valid driving license for the driver.

Option: Sea Fishing/Angling

We set off from Reykjavik's Old Harbour and head out to Faxaflói Bay, where our experienced fishermen will usually spot fish in a flash! If you haven't been sea fishing before, don't worry, it is very easy, and the crew will happily show you the ropes, advising you on bait and passing on their knowledge of the seas. On our sea angling trips you have a good chance of catching cod, halibut, haddock, rockfish and pollock. The sea angling tours are perfectly suited both to experienced fishermen and to those who simply wish to relax and enjoy the beautiful surrounding with a fishing rod in hand. Barbecuing the fish caught is indeed available and a popular option for the proud fishermen! Light BBQ on board catch.

Option : Snorkeling -

Silfra, the fissure between the continents

The Silfra fissure, is known as one of the top dive sites in the world for two main reasons. First, the Silfra fissure is actually a crack between the North American and Eurasian continents, meaning that you dive or snorkel right where the continental plates meet and fift apart about 2cm per year.

Silfra is the only place where one can dive or snorkel directly in the crack between two continental plates

Secondly, the underwater visibility in the Silfra fissure is over 100 meters, which creates an underwater experience that will rarely, if ever, be surpassed. The reasons for this astounding water clarity are twofold: the water is cold (2°C – 4°C year round) as it is glacial water from the nearby Langjökull and this water is filtered through porous underground lava for 30-100 years until it reaches the north end of Thingvellir lake, seeping out from underground wells. The Silfra water is as pristine as water can get and you can drink it at anytime during your dive or snorkel.

Option : Horseback Riding (half day)

Enjoy the here and now in Reykjavik City. We offer excellent facilities in Víðidalur where the largest equestrian centre for the Icelandic horse in the world is situated. The riding center is located by the main running course of the Equestrian Association Fákur where the National Horse Show in Iceland 2012 was held. Around 10.000 guests and riders visited and stayed there during the meet. The horses are then saddled and prepared for a riding tour with an experienced guide into the Rauc Jólar (Red Hills) and Heiðmörk overlooking Elliðavatn and along the banks of Rauðavatn.

Option: Whale Watching (half day)

Your whale watching adventure begins at Reykjavik's Old Harbour, just minutes away from the city centre! You will go whale watching on the biggest whale watching boat in Iceland, Andrea. The boat offers great comfort and an interior with a large outside viewing decks. The friendly guides, along with the captain and crew, point out where to spot the whales and give interesting information about the different kinds of whales and seabirds you can expect to see. Go for a whale watching with a high cruising speed, great fun for the adventurous!

Surprice option: Taste 1000 years old Glacier
